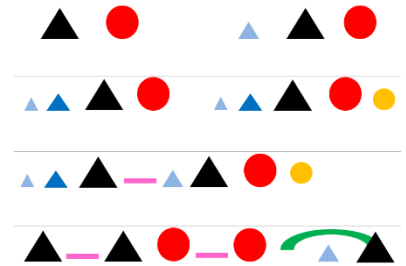


Introduction to Multisensory Grammar
